Letter Guidelines:

- Clearly state the position you're interested in
 - State why you are interested in the position
 - State your vision and goals for Honor Society and a few ideas about how to achieve these goals
 - This letter must be typewritten and double-spaced
5. If there is more than one candidate for an office, an election will be held.

What's the Commitment?

- Our officers act as an executive board for the chapter.
- Most officer meetings are held during lunch.
- Officers set the agenda for the year's activities, attend society events, conduct member meetings, visit 6th grade advisory classes to explain our organization, plan and execute the induction ceremony.
