 - **This option is for those that can't get JasperActive software to work**
 - **Or if you don't want to do JasperActive**
 - **You will be reviewing the Word Lesson 3 and 4 on a PowerPoint document and responding to what you learned.**

Microsoft Testing is now available online. I've added a new section on my website named Certification Testing. There are tutorials and directions for taking the test at home. They've made some changes since last week that hopefully will make the process easier:

- Parents don't need to be a proctor anymore. It's a true honor system.
- To get you registered for a test, here's what I need from you:
 - Test you want to take (PowerPoint, Word, Excel, etc.)
 - 3 Different preferred times and dates you would be available to take the test.
 - Choose times from 8am -3pm (they are on Mountain time)
 - Monday-Friday
- Once I have all your information, I will register you.
- Certiport will give me a time slot and link to login to your test.
- I will provide you the link 1 hour before the test to help you get set up.
- After that, Certiport will be helping you the rest of the way.
